Inspector Furness,

1. The entry in the A-Z list of government department and agencies in Australian Government Directory¹ for the National Anti-Corruption Commission² states:

The National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC) is an independent agency that prevents, detects, investigates and reports on serious or systemic corruption across the Commonwealth public sector. It educates the public service, and the public, about corruption risks and prevention.

The NACC is independent from government. This means the government cannot tell the NACC what to investigate (or what not to investigate), or how to do its job. The NACC will be able to investigate alleged corruption and report on what it finds. The NACC is led by a Commissioner and up to three Deputy Commissioners, with support from a Chief Executive Officer.

Statutory Declaration

I, Robert Thorpe, 21 Smith St, Fitzroy VIC 3065, community radio host, make the following statutory declaration under the **Oaths and Affirmations Act 2018**:

1. Here³ is a completed National Anti-Corruption Commission ("NACC") Corruption Reporting Form⁴ ("CRF") signed by an Elder, Alma Thorpe, and Robert Thorpe and dated Sunday 5 November 2023.
2. The last lines of the CRF on the NACC website contain an acknowledgement-statement⁵ identical to the one in the footer of every page of the NACC website⁶.
3. We request that you delete that acknowledgement-statement wherever it occurs and insert in its stead the attached Truth-Telling⁷ admission.
