## Thorpe v Dreyfus – Federal Court of Australia – purported s 78B notice

We act for the Commonwealth Attorney-General in relation to your notice pursuant to s 78B of the Judiciary Act 1903 of a constitutional issue, dated 27 May 2024. We are replying on the Attorney-General's behalf.

Your correspondence states that your originating application, statement of claim and notice pursuant to s 78B of the Judiciary Act 1903 have not yet been accepted for filing, so the proceeding has not been commenced. We understand your previous proceeding in the Federal Court (VID388/2024) was discontinued on 17 May 2024. So far as we are aware, there are no current proceedings on foot in the Federal Court in your name. In these circumstances, the question of the Attorney-General's intervention does not arise, and we do not propose to deal further with your notice.
